





Vietnam has over the past few decades grown from a poor and war-torn country to a lower middle-income economy with a GDP per capita > USD 2 000. However, several challenges stand in the way of taking the next growth leap, such as the need to enhance human capital, upgrade infrastructure and increasing productivity – areas where Vietnam is lagging behind today. How can











Vietnam work to increase its competitiveness to accelerate growth and take a larger regional role? What role does innovation play and what learnings can be drawn from Swedish experiences? The Executive Roundtable will feature industry leaders, policy makers and thought leaders from Sweden and Vietnam, discussing how innovation and competitiveness can be fostered to drive economic growth. The roundtable is divided into three sections (please see separate concept note for further information):

- How can government, business and academia work together to foster innovation and competitiveness?
- How can Vietnam leverage the EU-Vietnam FTA and ongoing China-US tensions to emerge as a global manufacturing hub?
- How should Vietnam work in order to deliver sustainable and inclusive growth to the growing middle class in the face of rapid urbanization?
